### 1. Psalm 1:1-6

“Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.

But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.

He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season

and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. Not so the wicked!

They are like chaff that the wind blows away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgement, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.

For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.”

### 2. Psalm 139:1-14

O LORD, you have searched me and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise;

You perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down;

You are familiar with all my ways.

Before a word is on my tongue, you know it completely, O LORD.

You hem me in – behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me.

Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence?

If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there.

If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea,

even the darkness will not be dark to you; for the night will shine like the day,

**3. 2 Timothy 3:16-17**

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”

**4. James 1:2-5**

**8. 1 Timothy 2:1-2**

**9. 2 Timothy 2:15**

“Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.”

**10. 1 Corinthians 16:13-14**

“Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be men of courage; be strong. Do everything in love.”

**11. Joshua 22:5**

**12. 1 John 1:8-9**

**13. 1 Timothy 1:15-16**

But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display His unlimited patience as an example for those who would believe on Him and receive eternal life.”

**14. Psalm 121:1-3**

“I lift up my eyes to the hills – where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth. He will not let your foot slip – He who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.”

**15. Hebrews 13:5-6**

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.” So we say with confidence, “The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?”

**16. 2 Peter 1:3**

**17. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20**

**18. Psalm 33:13-15**

**21. Proverbs 16:18-19**

**22. Proverbs 4:20-23**

“My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to a man’s whole body. Above all else, guard your heart, for it is a wellspring of life.”

**23. Psalm 103:11-12**

“For as high as the heavens are above the earth,  
so great is His love for those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west,  
so far has He removed our transgressions from us.”

**24. Hebrews 3:12-13**

“See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart  
that turns away from the living God. But encourage one another daily,

be hardened by sin’s deceitfulness.”

**25. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14**

“Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter:

**26. Ephesians 3:20-21**

for ever and ever! Amen.”

**27. Romans 12:16-18**

“Live in harmony with one another.  
Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position.  
Do not be conceited. Do not repay anyone evil for evil.  
Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody.  
If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.”

**28. Psalm 145:17-18**

“The LORD is righteous in all his ways and loving toward all he has made.  
The LORD is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth.”

**29. 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13**

“Now we ask you, brothers, to respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other.”

**30. Isaiah 53:5-6**
